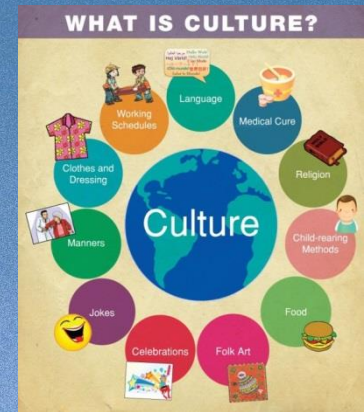




Culture

Today, the world is fast becoming a global village, with many countries enjoying a multicultural environment. Understanding different cultures is not only critical, but it also promotes ample coexistence.



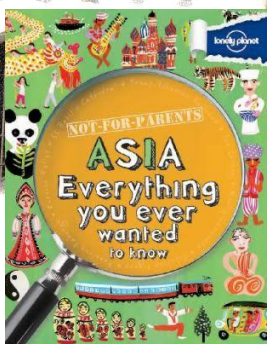
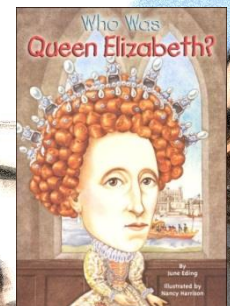
The benefits of understanding different cultures:

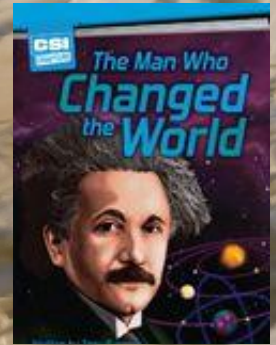

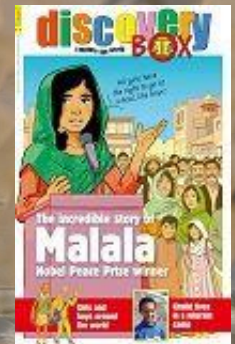
The Man Who Changed the World

From a very young age, Albert Einstein questioned the world around him. He didn't have power, strength or a lot of money. Yet he still managed to change the world. So how did he do it?



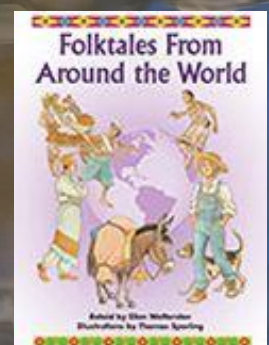
